Senior Schooling Learning Agreement Year 11 and 12 in 2027 PO Box 138, Prospect Street, Lowood QLD 4311

As part of the Senior Education and Training (SET) Plan process, students and parents/carers **confirm the decision to continue senior schooling at Lowood State High School in 2027**. Moving into Year 11 and Year 12 means entering the senior phase of learning and the compulsory participation phase of education. Our staff are committed to supporting every senior student to participate successfully, achieve their Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) or Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement (QCIA), and progress towards their agreed pathway. This agreement outlines the expectations that support learning, engagement and continued enrolment in the senior schooling program.

Course of study

Students are expected to take responsibility for their course of study and intended pathway. This includes knowing their subjects or program, understanding how they are progressing, reflecting on current performance, and setting future learning and pathway goals.

Senior schooling expectations

To be successful and maintain a continued enrolment, students must demonstrate the following:

Area	Expectation
Attendance and punctuality	✓ Arrive on time to school and attend all scheduled classes, including Home Group, WEL and Wednesday program offerings. ✓ Maintain attendance of 85% or greater. ✓ Attendance is calculated by lessons present each week. ✓ Only a medical certificate will be considered to offset a student's actual attendance rate.
Learning and participation	✓ Actively participate in the educational program provided and engage in the agreed pathway. ✓ The school may offer alternative or limited pathways where students are unable to meet senior schooling expectations.
Assessment	✓ Complete all assessments and submit work by draft and final due dates. ✓ Follow the School's Assessment Policy published on the Lowood SHS website. ✓ Students may apply for AARA when extenuating circumstances exist, with supporting documentation submitted through Student Reception.
Behaviour, uniform and technology	✓ Wear the correct uniform each day. ✓ Uphold all School Policies, including the Student Code of Conduct. ✓ Achieve a satisfactory standard for effort and behaviour on all Report Cards.
Fees and resources	✓ Be financial by having no outstanding school fees or having a payment plan in place. ✓ Return all borrowed school equipment in a timely manner.
Leaving school grounds and driving	✓ Do not leave the school grounds during school time unless signed out through Student Reception with appropriate documentation or permissions. ✓ Students who drive to school must follow all road rules and regulations and park only in allotted public spaces.
