Subject Descriptions

- **Dance** – Students will explore dance for children and Just Dance contexts when performing and creating their own dances.
- **Drama** – Students will explore the difference between realistic and comical acting when performing and creating scenes.
- **Economics and Business** – Students will develop computer literacy skills and venture into the business world exploring how it operates, and who benefits.
- **Football Academy** – Students will work on Football skills, fitness and game planning.
- **Horticulture** - Students will participate in theory and practical lessons learning about weather, water and worms with plant propagation and sustainability.
- **Music** – Students will explore music from different cultures and genres and experiment with fundamental performance and compassion skills.
- **Material Technologies Specialisations (Manual Arts and Graphics)** - Students will develop skills to design, produce and evaluate products that may combine timber, metal and acrylics within a workshop environment.
- **Food Specialisations (Home Economics)** – Students will learn the basics of cooking and kitchen safety and will learn how to use pantry staples and flavours to create delicious simple dishes.
- **Art** - Students will design and make art while exploring drawing, painting, clay work and printmaking.
