Learn how to:

- work safely in the workplace
- communicate well with others
- provide first aid and CPR
- work with people from different backgrounds

Program delivery

A 12 to 18-month traineeship means you will:

- attend the workplace one day a week
- complete an average of 7.5 hours each week (375 hours in total)
- study either the Certificate III in Health Services Assistance or the Certificate III in Business
- learn through on-the-job training, classroom sessions and online activities.
