The school operates a voluntary Student Resource Scheme (SRS) under the Department of Education (DoE) guidelines. The Scheme aims to provide all students with the necessary basic textbooks and associated learning materials at considerable savings to parents. Parents have the choice of either joining the scheme OR privately purchasing all the various textbooks, novels and other materials as well as paying for the general curriculum resource charge which includes resources relating to that subject area. Personal stationery items are not provided as part of the Scheme. New students to Lowood State High School will be required to complete the Student BYOD Charter Agreement Form available at Student Reception.

Parent contribution for the Student Resource Scheme (SRS) 2024 is \$200 per student.

Laptops - All students are required to have their own digital device for learning (BYOD – Bring Your Own Device). Students are encouraged to bring their laptop from the start of the school year.

Distribution of textbooks in 2024 – Textbooks will be available to students after school commences.
